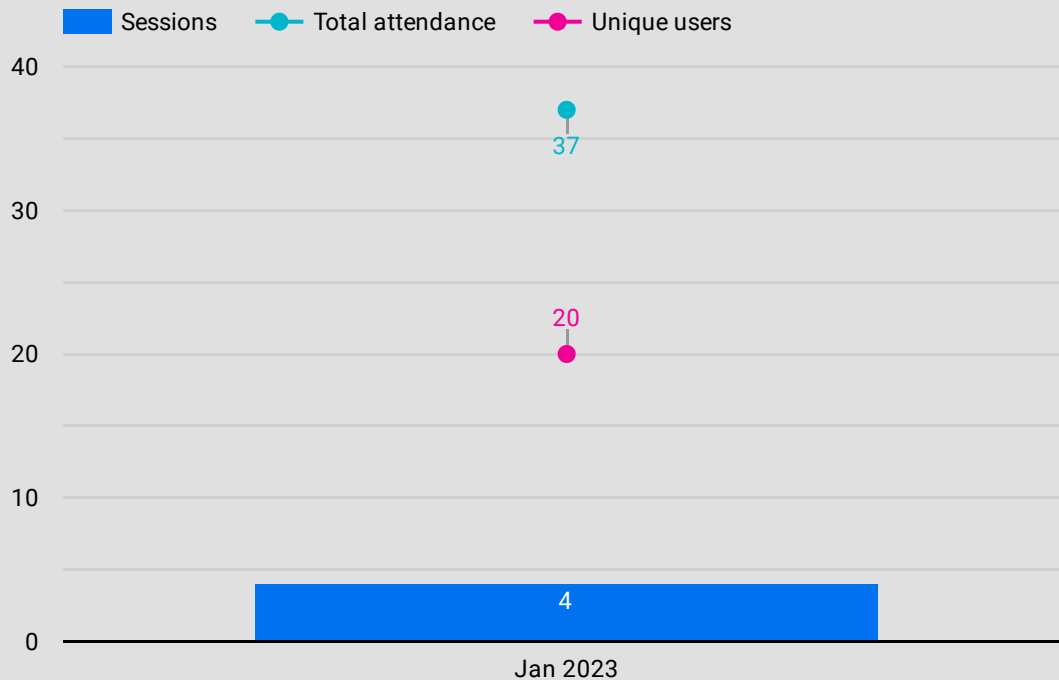


Girls Skate Sessions.

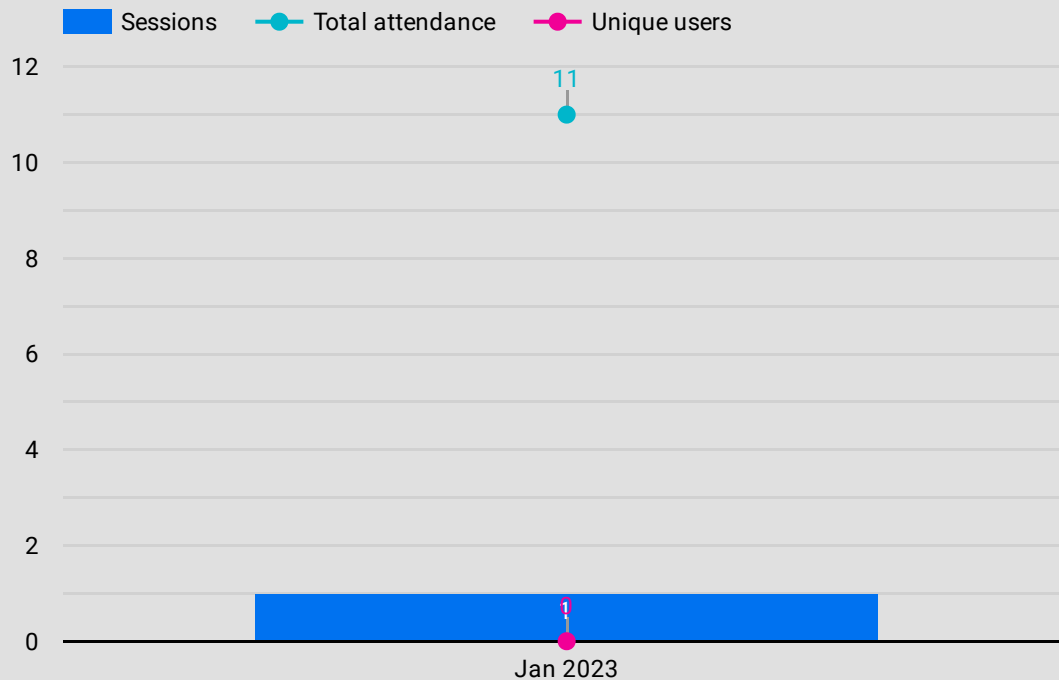


Community Activities.

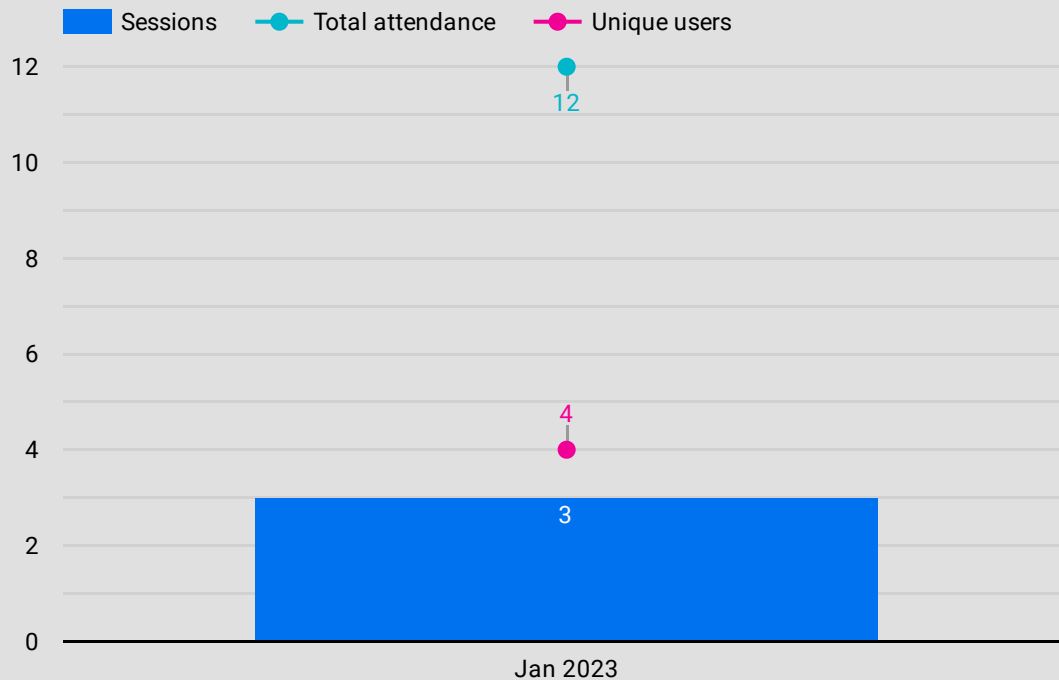


Disability Sessions.
